5 The Qualification of the Student

(1) Educational background

(ก) Graduate Diploma; the student must have a bachelor's degree or equivalent from a higher education institution which has been certified by the Ministry of Education.

(ข) Higher Graduate Diploma; the student must have a master's degree or equivalent from a higher education institution which has been certified by the Ministry of Education.

(ค) Master's Degree; the student must have a bachelor's degree or equivalent from a higher education institution which has been certified by the Ministry of Education.

(ง) Doctoral degree; the student must have bachelor's degree or equivalent with excellent achievement or master's degree or equivalent from a higher education institution which has been certified by the Ministry of Education.

(2) A student must not have been convicted and imprisoned as the final judgement of the court except if the student was convicted of negligence or a misdemeanor charge.

(3) A student must not be expelled from an education institution because of misconduct.

(4) A student must be healthy and not have a disease or any condition which can be a barrier in studying.

(5) A student must have qualifications as the university requires.

6 Admission

(1) The University will consider the applicant who has been selected or taken the examination or else as prescribed by the university and the student will be informed in a timely manner.

(2) The applicant who has passed the selection but is awaiting the examination results will be allowed to register when the student has all qualifications within the prescribed of time.

7 Type of student

(1)Regular student means a student who has all the qualifications as mentioned in No. 5, and the University will admit him/her to study for a graduate diploma, master degree, higher graduate diploma or doctoral degree.

(2) Special student means a student who does not have all the qualifications as mentioned in No. 5, but the University will allow him/her to have conditional status to study for 1 academic year. The student's status will change when he/she has all qualifications and is approved by the University; however, if the student does not fulfill the conditions he/she will be expelled.

8 Transferred student

The University may consider a graduate student for admission from another university or other domestic or international higher education institution, so they can register for coursework or individual study. A student can transfer the credits and student achievement to apply in his/her study plan as the declaration of university or domestic or international higher education institution or Naresuan University.

9 Study participant

The University will consider other students besides Naresuan University graduate students to be study participants in some courses as approved by the curriculum committee, and the study participant will receive a certificate for that course.

10 Student Registration

The applicant who has passed the admissions as per the Naresuan University Declaration must register to be a NU student in the prescribed time; otherwise, admission will be forfeited.

11 Instructional System

The instructional system of Naresuan University is a 2 semester system: each academic year has been divided into 2 ordinary semesters and the study period will not be less than 15 weeks. In some curricula, there is a summer semester for which the time and credits is equal to a regular semester.

12 The education system has been divided into 2 types as follows:

(1) A regular education means a student must study weekdays with full time enrollment.

(2) Special education means a student must study weekends and does not have full time enrollment.

14 Credit Calculation

(1) Theory courses which have a lecture class or discussion of not less than 15 hours/regular semester will equal 1 credit in the 2 semester system.

(2) Practical courses which have a practicum or experimental class of not less than 30 hours/regular semester will equal 1 credit in the 2 semester system.

(3) Internship or field training which has a training class of not less than 45 hours/ regular semester will equal 1 credit in the two semester system.

(4) Project or assigned activities which requires not less than 45 hours/regular semester will equal 1 credit in the two semester system.

(5) Independent study which requires not less than 90 hours/regular semester will equal 1 credit in the two semester system.

(6) Thesis courses which require not less than 45 hours/regular semester will equal 1 credit in the two semester system.
